ORDERED that the Defendant shall perform the conditions, stipulations, and agreements herein set forth; and that the terms of said Agreement shall be binding upon the Defendant, as set forth in this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the Defendant shall be released on his own recognizance during the term of this Agreement, unless otherwise specifically ordered by this Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the Court shall retain jurisdiction of this cause, to enforce said Pre-Trial Intervention Agreement.

**AGREEMENT**

**THIS AGREEMENT**, entered into this **28** day of **April, 2025** by and between **Edward Cullum**, Defendant, **Eric Evilsizer**, Attorney for Defendant, and **BRUCE BARTLETT**, State Attorney, Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, by and through his undersigned Assistant.

1. The Parties agree that this Agreement shall be effective only upon approval of the Court.
2. It is agreed that Defendant meets the criteria and qualifications for admission to the Program, and Defendant's Attorney, **Eric Evilsizer**, having fully investigated the case and having fully advised the Defendant, between **Edward Cullum** of his rights, believes it to be in the Defendant's best interest to enter into this Agreement.
3. It is understood and agreed that the Defendant shall participate in the Pre-Trial Intervention Program for a total period of **TWELVE (12) months**. Defendant specifically waives any and all rights contained in Section (2), Chapter 948.08, Florida Statutes.
4. **Edward Cullum**, Defendant, by and through his Attorney, **Eric Evilsizer**, agrees that in consideration for entering into this Agreement, the Defendant waives his right to a Speedy Trial as provided by law, and further, that the Defendant's right to a Speedy Trial shall resume only on the new trial date for the charge if rejected by the Program for any reason or upon a resumption of this pending charge pursuant to 948.08, Florida Statutes.
5. For the purpose of this Program, the Defendant acknowledges and accepts responsibility for the crime for which he is charged, said acknowledgment not to be used against his in the event of future prosecution. The parties agree that such acknowledgment is the first step in rehabilitation.
6. The Defendant agrees that he will keep the Pre-Trial Program Supervisor advised of his current address throughout the entire program. Defendant further agrees that as part of the Program requirement he shall be obligated to appear in open court prior to being released from the Program. The Defendant's failure to appear in open court when properly noticed at his last known address shall constitute a violation of the terms of this Agreement and the Defendant recognized that he may then be withdrawn from the Program and the original prosecution reinstated.
7. The Defendant, and his Attorney, warrant that Defendant meets the eligibility criteria and has no prior criminal record, other than as stated on attached statement of prior arrest record and is not on probation for a prior crime, charge, or conviction. Defendant agrees that he will be completely law-abiding during the term of this Agreement. At the conclusion of the Program and prior to dismissal, the Defendant shall submit an Affidavit, under oath, attesting to the fact that he has not been arrested for any reason while on the Program.
8. The Defendant voluntarily agrees to make restitution in the case to the victim, **N/A**, in the amount of **\$N/A**, with a minimum monthly payment of **\$N/A**. The Defendant agrees to pay a 4% surcharge on all monetary conditions and to pay all said conditions by guaranteed form of payment to Department of Corrections.
9. The Defendant agrees to submit himself to a psychological examination if ordered. The Defendant further agrees the cost of such psychological counseling shall be his responsibility.
10. The Parties stipulate that this Agreement shall in no way, operate as a contract for immunity from prosecution for the Charge referred to herein and further, should Defendant fail to meet the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Agreement shall be void at the discretion of the State Attorney or the Court, or either of them, without Notice of Hearing, and prosecution may then be instituted.
11. The Defendant agrees to work regularly at a lawful occupation and/or participate in other programs for evaluation or treatment established for him under the supervision of the Department of Corrections, Defendant paying the costs of said program and/or evaluations. The Defendant further agrees that upon entering the program, as well as upon any changes of employment, he will notify his employer of his Pre-Trial Intervention status.



12. The Defendant agrees not to change their residence, employment or leave the county of their residence without first procuring the consent of their Pre-Trial Intervention Officer.
13. The Defendant agrees to report in person on a monthly basis to his Pre-Trial Intervention Officer and make a full and truthful report on the form provided for that purpose or as instructed by their Pre-Trial Intervention Officer.
14. The Defendant further agrees to truthfully answer all inquiries and carry out all instructions of his Pre-Trial Intervention Supervisor, and grants permission for his said Officer to visit his home, place of employment, school, or other location, for the purpose of carrying out adequate supervision.
15. The Defendant agrees to do the following, in addition to the above: **\$50.00 per month payable to Department of Corrections for Cost of Supervision; \$120.00 Court Costs; SAO Processing Fee \$100.00. Additional Conditions: \$52.00 Investigative Fee to the Pasco County Sheriff's Office, \$30.00 drug screen fee. Pay \$12.00 per year for First Step, Inc. payable to Department of Corrections to be paid on or before 90 days from date of the Agreement and a \$00.00 Indigent Criminal Defense Fee.** The Defendant agrees to complete all monetary community service and treatment conditions 60 days prior to the termination of this agreement. The Defendant agrees to pay a 4% surcharge on all monetary conditions and to pay all conditions by the guaranteed form of payment to the Department of Corrections.
16. BRUCE BARLETT, State Attorney, Sixth Judicial Circuit, by and through his undersigned Assistant, hereby warrants and agrees that, should between **Edward Cullum**, Defendant, fully meet the terms and conditions of this Agreement as determined by said State Attorney, the charges shall be dismissed.
17. It is stipulated and agreed that the State Attorney's decision regarding full compliance in this regard shall be final and shall not be reviewable by any Court.
18. The Defendant will not have in his possession, or attempt to purchase, a firearm or weapon while participating in this program.
19. Defendant will not use intoxicants to excess, possess or use any illegal drugs. Defendant will submit to random urinalysis as required by supervising officer or drug treatment facility. All urinalysis and treatment costs will be the defendant's responsibility.
20. Defendant will have no contact with victims.
21. Defendant agrees to complete a Psychological Evaluation and Treatment.
22. Defendant agrees to complete fifty (25) hours of community service.
23. Defendant agrees to complete Anger Management.
